<p>CONTEXT: Germany's foreign policy under Hitler involved two aims:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. reclaiming land taken by the Treaty of Versailles 2. expanding Germany's living space (<i>lebensraum</i>) to create an Empire. <p>This cartoon was drawn when he had achieved much of his first aim, and had begun to achieve some of his second aim.</p>
<p>OBJECTIVES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Analyse an historical cartoon • Explain the message of the cartoon • Use appropriate details from the cartoon to support your explanation
<p>ASSESSMENT: You will get marks for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Saying what the message of the cartoon is • Explaining the message • Using details from the cartoon to show this • Using your own background knowledge to explain
<p>TASK: What is the message of the cartoon? Use details of the cartoon and your own knowledge to explain your answer. 6 marks</p> <p>What to do:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Look carefully at the details of the cartoon. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is <i>Ex French-British Family</i> on the bed head? • Who are the children in the bed? • The words on the sack, <i>Deutschland über alles</i> means 'Germany above all others'. • The caption of the cartoon is "Europe can look forward to a Christmas of peace", says Hitler. • What has been happening in Europe when this cartoon was drawn in October 1938? 2. You might need to look up some words or check your background knowledge in your notes or using the textbook. 3. Now try to answer the question. Try to use at least four details from the cartoon in your answer. Also try to explain what some of the references mean (after all the cartoon <u>assumes</u> you know what is going on in October 1938).
