## **English Language and Literature**

**Language** Pupil Drive - AQA past papers, Knowledge Organisers that set out how to answer each reading and writing question and videos made by English staff to remind how to narratively write and how to write a persuasive piece too.

**Literature** Pupil Drive - there are AQA past papers, videos made by English staff writing answers in real time and Knowledge Organisers and quote banks.

*Macbeth, A Christmas Carol* and *An Inspector Calls* are our set texts along with the fifteen poems from the Power and Conflict cluster of poetry.

Mr Bruff literature videos are excellent for subject knowledge as are Stacey Reay's videos too. CGP guides and any other brand are good for subject knowledge but students should stick to the structures taught in class and detailed in our Knowledge Organisers.

### Music

A key words list and revision guide will be given to pupils around Easter time.

They have end of area of study summary resources in their books e.g. key word lists and timelines.

There is a folder on pupil drive with all revision resources including lots of listening examples. Pupils should use their 'Hello Dearie' notes in their books to support this listening. The exam is all about using what you KNOW to inform what you can HEAR.

1. Learn the facts. Use your HDTTIMR.

2. LISTEN. Pupils should listen and write down all the key features they can hear. It is a good idea to also try and describe what they are hearing to somebody else.

Pupils should look back over the feedback they have received for exam style questions and their mocks. This will help them to approach questions.

There is an OCR revision guide which is fine. I personally don't think the material is as well organised as that in their books
