

LOGGING INTO GO4SCHOOLS FOR THE FIRST TIME

1. Go to www.go4schools.com via the internet and click on the "Parents" icon in the top right corner of the home page.

2. Type your e-mail address, which will be your user name, into the box in the First time User section and click on "Please send me a password".
