NEW Year 11 Photography Exhibition

On Tuesday 5th December from 6pm to 8pm we will be holding an evening showcasing the innovative work of our year 11 Photography pupils in the Walnut Gallery.

The work is an exploration of a portrait photography project under the title of 'Disguise'. Pupils have experimented with a range of camera techniques as well as the use of photoshop editing software to distort, manipulate and disguise their images. Pupils have been given the freedom to explore a range of topics such as surrealism, mental health and the psychology of colour under the theme of Disguise.

NEW Year 7 and Year 8 Unifrog online careers platform

In their Computer Science lessons this week, Year 7 and 8 pupils have been introduced to Unifrog, an online tool designed to help them to think about possible future pathways. Each pupil now has their own account where they can explore all the career and next step options available to them; find information on a range of work-related topics such as managing their workload, developing good study habits and writing successful applications and CVs; and begin to record activities they have completed and skills they have developed. We would encourage you to use the platform with your child so you can support them through the process of deciding their next step.

You can also have your own Unifrog account. You'll be able to research careers, attend webinars delivered by employers and universities to learn more about their opportunities, and compare pathways so you can support your child in making an informed decision about their next steps.
