Key stage 4 options process, 2024

This letter outlines the key dates in the options process by which Year 9 pupils will be asked to identify their preferred options courses for Years 10 and 11.

- 24 January: Launch to pupils Year 9 Careers Conference
 During lessons, pupils will be introduced to the key elements of the options process.
 They will receive a copy of the options booklet to bring home and they will begin to find out about the range of optional courses on offer.
- □ **25 January: Launch to parents Year 9 Options Evening (6.30 8pm)**Parents are invited to this in-person event, starting at 6.30pm in the Henry Morris Hall.
 Following an introductory presentation outlining the main aspects of the process, Subject Leaders will be on hand to answer specific questions on the range of optional courses on offer.
- □ **1 February: Year 9 spring reports issued**Spring term progress reports will support decision making by giving parents and pupils an update on progress and engagement in each subject area.
- □ **8 February: Year 9 Parents' Consultation Evening (Online)**This will be an opportunity for parents and pupils to meet with subject teachers, to discuss current levels of performance and to understand the suitability of different courses. You will receive a separate letter concerning appointments for this event.
- 26 February 8 March: An Options Interview Parents and pupils will be invited to an interview with a senior member of staff. This is not a selection process but a chance to discuss choices and to receive further, individual guidance. Interviews will last 15 minutes and you will receive an appointment time next month.

The final deadline for submitting the option choices is **11 March**. A link to the required form will be shared when parents and pupils are invited to their options interview. If we are unable to offer first choices and need to use reserves then you will be contacted. Confirmation of the final offer will be sent home by the end of May.
