IMPORTANT Catering Price Increases 2024-5

Unfortunately, from September 2024 there will be an average increase of 2.0% in the cost of items purchased in the catering outlets provided by Innovate. The price of the daily meal deal will increase to £2.75. Anglian Learning, the trust of which College is a member, has worked hard with our catering provider to limit this increase. Please find here a letter from them outlining the reasons for the increase along with the cost of a sample of items from September 2024.

For those eligible for free school meals the daily allowance will increase from £2.60 to £2.75. COMMUNITY Free bus pass for under 25's

The mayor of Cambs and Peterborough has brought in a new, free bus pass for anyone under 25 which gives them £1 fares anywhere within Cambs and Peterborough. Cutting in half the cost of a trip into Cambridge from Sawston.

It's particularly relevant for anyone with children in year 11 looking at bus passes to get to sixth form next year - getting this free pass and the £1 fare will work out about half as much as a pupil yearly pass $\underline{\texttt{£1 Bus Fare}}$ - Cambridgeshire & Peterborough Combined Authority.
