You should know 10-15 quotations for each text -add your quotations to flashcards or one of the apps here and practise them a few times a week. Get a parent or friend to test you! Then, annotate your quotations with language analysis and use them to plan past paper questions from the AQA website

Maths	CorbettMaths 5 a day	Use the link daily. Select a 5-a-day worksheet that is appropriate to your tier and minimum grade and answer the questions. Check your answers using the solutions provided. A knowledge organiser may help you recall methods, these are available to purchase on WisePay.
