

Options 2026 – Summary Guidance

A suggested approach:

1. Read through the full options booklet [HERE](#).

3. Access online careers and college websites to get some ideas about future pathways [HERE](#).
4. Identify an initial 'shortlist' of subjects in each option block.
5. Use the spring progress reports, conversations at parents evening and online careers research to refine thinking.
6. Attend the online guidance interview with a senior leader if at all possible.
7. Finalise your choice in each option block, plus at least one reserve.
8. Complete the electronic form that was emailed to pupils with their invitation to a guidance interview Deadline: **4pm on Monday 9 March.***
