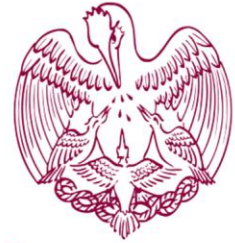

Year 8 Activities Week, 15-20 June 2026: Theatre Trip

The Sawston Arts team are delighted to announce our Year 8 Activities Week, taking place in the week commencing Monday 15 June. After previous years' well-received delivery of Art, Music and Drama, we will continue to work closely as a team to produce and perform our own adaptation of one of Shakespeare's well-known plays.

As part of this exciting week, we will be taking pupils to see a matinee of the brand-new stage adaptation of 'The Karate Kid' at Milton Keynes Theatre, on **Wednesday 17 June**. This thrilling new musical production, making its UK and West End premiere, promises to re-create the 1984 film that inspired martial arts fever, with added theatricality. This is a super opportunity for our pupils to experience a full professional production ahead of their own final performance at the end of Activities Week.

For the visit, pupils should wear school uniform and bring both a packed lunch to eat before the show and packed tea to eat afterwards. The performance starts at 2.30 pm and ends at 5.00 pm. We will travel by coach to Milton Keynes, leaving the College at around 11.30 am and returning by 7.30 pm. A further letter nearer the time will give more detailed return timings.

Milton Keynes Theatre is only able to hold the booking for a short time, so we are asking for a quick turnaround for your consent and payment via WisePay. The cost of this theatre trip is £50 per pupil, payable via the 'Trips and Visits' area of WisePay.
